ANOTHER TRAVESTY IN THE WORLD OF ADOPTION

Kimberly Rossler needs our help. If you are not already familiar with the details of this situation you can Google the story BRING BABY ELLIOTT HOME or read the recent two part article in the Huffington Post. Becoming a mother is one of the most endearing and memorable times in the life of a parent. For Kimberly Rossler this all came to a crashing end when her son, Elliott, was taken from her by sheriff's deputies when he was just 3 weeks old.

Kimberly had contemplated adoption and per Alabama state law signed a pre-birth consent. Before his birth Kimberly decided to parent her son and informed the appropriate parties. Because of (now apparent) alleged conflicts of interests on the part of the adoption attorney and the judge who approved her pre-birth consent, Kimberly was led to believe no further action needed to be taken.

At the end of May she gave birth to Elliott and became his mother. Overjoyed and at peace for the first time in a long time, Kimberly brought Elliott home for 3 blissful weeks. While she was nursing her newborn son, a sheriff's deputy knocked on her door with a court order in his hands, and said he was there to retrieve Elliott. The court order had been obtained on claims she was mentally unstable, and the sheriff's deputy was to transfer Elliott into the custody of the prospective adoptive parent involved in this case. This prospective adoptive parent had never even seen Elliott and the claims were false.

This campaign has been created to help Kimberly with her legal fees. While Kimberly's attorney has offered his services pro bono, there are still expected to be costs incurred for filing fees, transcripts, appeals (if necessary), investigative fees, and travel expenses.

Concerned United Birthparents has stepped in to set up and monitor donated funds. CUB's sole purpose is to raise funds in order to return Elliott home to his mother. All proceeds for this campaign go directly to Kimberly's attorney to be used for expenses related directly to Kimberly's case.
